Changes to COVID Testing

To accommodate election polling during the first week of November, there will be **no** asymptomatic COVID surveillance testing at Leverone Fieldhouse on Monday (11/2) or Tuesday (11/3). Hours will be extended to 4pm on Thursday and Friday, and Leverone will be open for testing on Saturday 11/7 from 10am to 3pm. As a reminder, this is asymptomatic surveillance testing for Dartmouth employees working on-site. If you are not working onsite or are experiencing COVID symptoms please seek testing through your PCP or DHMC.

COVID-19 Prevention Training

Employees who work on campus are required to participate in an online training program called, "COVID-19 Prevention: Staying Healthy in a Changing Environment for All Employees." This 20-30 minute course is a refresher on basic information regarding COVID-19 as well as related Dartmouth College policies, procedures, and workplace expectations. Employees who must take the course are identified through TSA screening and will be contacted via email.
