Radio System Goes Live

The new Motorola WAVE radio system went into production this week and is now being actively used by FO&M, Safety & Security, and others who need real-time communications between individuals or within small talk groups. As part of the project, new radio antennas have been installed on various campus buildings, extending from the Dartmouth Skiway to DHMC.

According to Software Engineer and project lead Tom Mitchell, "Motorola WAVE is a carrier-independent broadband Push-to-Talk (PTT) service that uses the cloud to extend instantaneous private and group communication to phones and tablets. It extends the Dartmouth Campus Radio System to anywhere a user connects their mobile device."

New system training was provided by Senior Work Process Administrator Phil Charboneau who created a user-friendly [training video](http://www.dartmouth.edu/fom/services/work_control/) that is posted to www.dartmouth.edu/fom/services/work_control/.
