Thanks to Transportation Services for sharing the following updates on shuttle services:

Effective Monday, Aug. 30, the Advance Transit (AT) Dartmouth/Downtown shuttle will resume daytime school-year service levels. Also resuming that day is the Dartmouth evening AT shuttle between DHMC, Hanover, and Sachem Village. Information about AT routes and schedules is available at advancetransit.com.

Effective Monday, Aug. 30, the Lewiston Lot shuttle will resume 15-minute service, operating 7am to 7pm each weekday. The shuttle stops at the Ledyard Lot, Tuck Circle, North Main by Parkhurst, West Wheelock in front of the Saint Thomas Church, and the Lewiston Lot.
