Benefits Enrollment Starts Soon

The 2022 Benefits Open Enrollment period for faculty and staff will begin Monday, October 18, 8:00am and run through Monday, November 1, 11:59pm. This is your annual opportunity to review and change your benefits for 2022.

Please note, your current Flex Spending Accounts (FSA's) and/or Health Savings Account (HSA) elections will not automatically re-enroll in 2022. If you would like to continue to contribute to an FSA or an HSA, you must re-enroll for the new plan year during this Open Enrollment period. If no action is taken, you will be defaulted to the medical, dental, life insurance, long-term disability, and wellness program coverage you had at the end of 2021.

How is Campus Services Organized?

With nearly 550 employees Campus Services is a large division, responsible for caring for Dartmouth's landholdings and facilities and providing a variety of services to students and other constituents. We've heard some of our employees are unsure of how their particular department fits into the whole division, so here is a high-level summary of the [organization](#). All departments report up to Josh Keniston, who serves as Vice-President (VP) of both Campus Services and Institutional Projects. The heads of each of the following major areas constitute Josh's senior leadership team. Together they set goals for the division.

[Environmental Health & Safety \(EHS\)](#) provides guidance on occupational and lab safety, and environmental protection issues.

[Business & Hospitality Services](#) is comprised of departments that provide services in return for fees. These include [Dartmouth Dining](#), [Print & Mail Services](#), [Himan Mail](#), [Dartmouth Skiway](#), and the [Hanover Inn](#).

The [Planning Office](#) plans for and implements the long-term vision for the use and development of campus lands. They also manage campus space and maps.

In addition to the convenience of a season pass, passholders receive perks at other ski venues including Whaleback, Burke, Magic Mountain, Suicide Six and more.
