COVID-19 Update

With the number of COVID-19 cases on the rise in the area, please take extra precautions to keep yourself, your family, and those around you safe.

KN95 face masks and take-home rapid antigen tests are being distributed this week at the tent next to Parkhurst on Wednesday and Thursday from 12 to 7 p.m., and on Friday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Otherwise, free masks and tests are available at these [locations](#).

A **next COVID-19 vaccine clinic** for Dartmouth students, faculty, and staff will be held on Tuesday, April 26 from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. at Alumni Hall in the Hopkins Center. As reported by the COVID-19 Response team, "this clinic will have Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines available for those who would like to receive a primary series vaccine, a first booster, or a second booster.

Every participant must be registered online in order to receive a vaccination. Walk-ins will be accepted at the clinic; however, you should expect the registration and vaccination process to take about 30 minutes longer if you do not pre-register.

Students should also enter their NetID in the "Employee ID" field."
