In terms of next steps, there are several actions underway.

(1) We're actively recruiting for two new posi-

tions: a Campus Services Recruiter and a Director of Culture and Employee Belonging.

(2) A single cross-departmental committee, tentatively named "Together is Our Success", is being created to help produce actions in the following five areas: training, building community, communication, mentorship, and career advancement.
