New Projects Begin

Now that Commencement & Reunions are over, attention is turning to several new capital projects. Phase 1 construction is underway to renovate the Andres residence hall in the East Wheelock House. This year-long project will maximize energy performance and address accessibility, deferred maintenance, and program needs. Phase 2 renewal of neighboring Zimmerman residence hall and Brace Commons is scheduled for summer 2023 to summer 2024. In total, these projects, led by Reed Bergwall, will add study spaces and increase the overall bed count by 24 from 168 to 192.

In addition, Project Manager Jason Rouillard is leading construction of a new [Library Storage and Records Management facility](#) at 54 Etna Road which



will add capacity for expected Library collections growth for at least the next 15 years. Interestingly, the south façade will have a decorative multi-color metal scrim to simulate the appearance of books on a shelf.

According to IT Manager Robin Pych, "the cart will be delivered to a specified location and picked up when the rental is over. The rental cost is \$10 per laptop per day.
