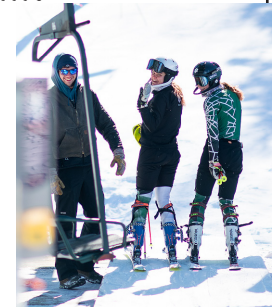
You should have confidence that the survey is completely anonymous and confidential, as it is being managed by Deo Mwano Consulting. Consolidated results will be shared with all divisional employees.
