<u>Sachem Village</u> may be out of sight, but it's not out of mind for Real Estate, FO&M, and Project Management Services employees who are working to renovate a number of Sachem residences.

For those not familiar with it, Sachem Village is a neighborhood comprised of 255 residences, offered exclusively to the Dartmouth community and located less than 2 miles south of downtown Hanover in Lebanon, NH. It is managed by the Real Estate Office, and is very popular amongst graduate students.

Sachem was built in phases starting in 1965. Currently underway is phase 1 of a 4-phase project to fully renovate 24 residential units in North Sachem by 2027.

According to Project Manager Drew Miraldi, renovation work started "in August with abatement/demo of 6 units on Haddock Lane. Then in Oct., we started the interior renovations... which include new kitchen and appliances; sprinkler system and addressable fire alarm; flooring, paint & finishes; and new baseboard heating and insulation. We are shooting for an early Feb. finish date."
