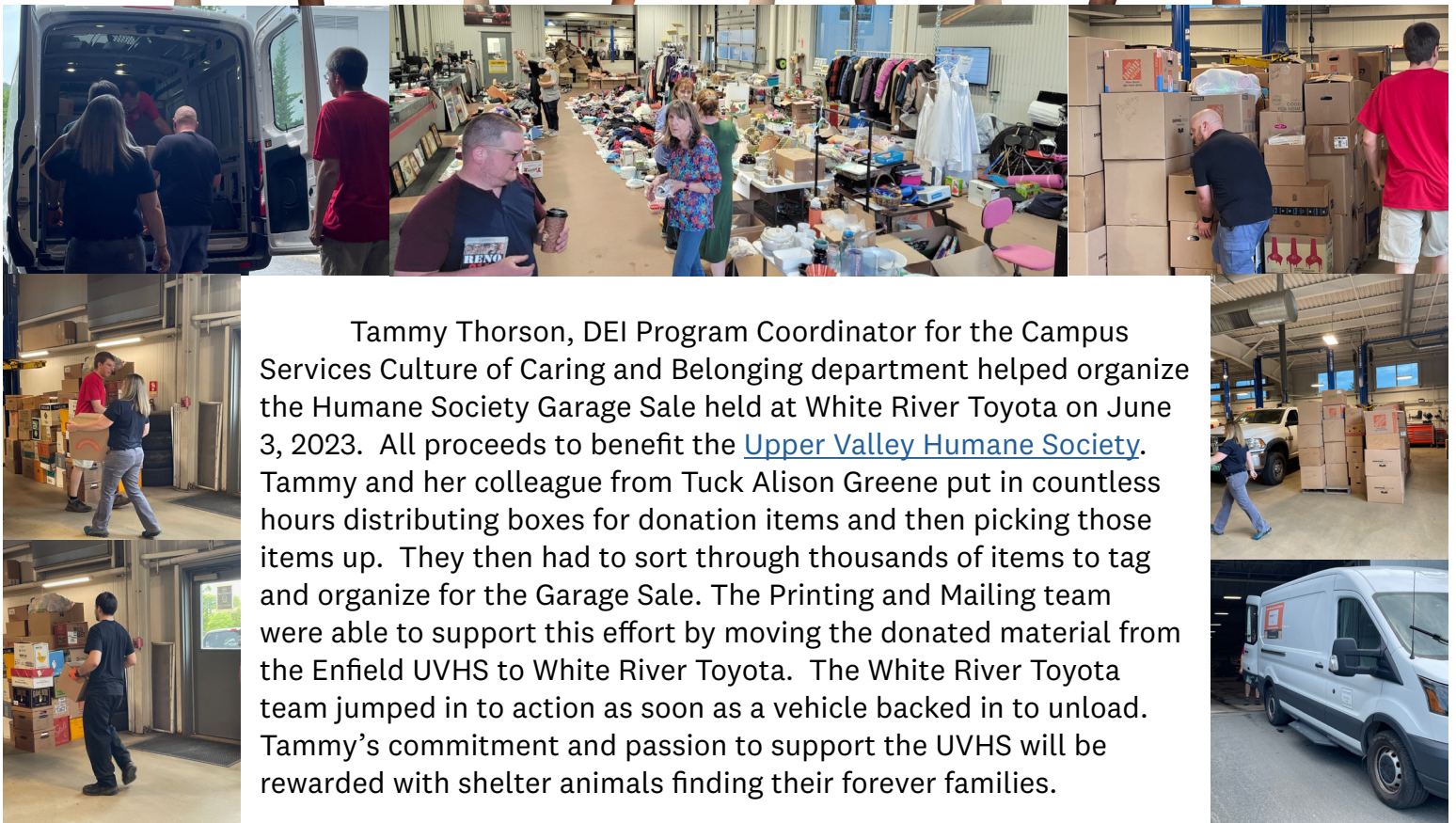

JUNE TEENTH

Freedom Day

June 19, 1865, known as Juneteenth, was the day—two years after the Emancipation Proclamation of 1863—that enslaved people of African descent who lived in Galveston, Texas, learned from Union troops that slavery had been abolished. For



generations, Black communities across the country have observed Juneteenth, and in 2021 President Biden signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act, officially designating the day as a federal holiday.
